If the Court finds probable cause to believe that the Respondent is in possession of firearms, then (1) the Court <i>SHALL</i> issue a warrant for the seizure of the firearms; and (2) the Court <i>MAY</i> issue a search warrant to locate the firearms. (See Warrant form attached.)

DEFINITION OF TERMS USED IN THIS ORDER						

These definitions are incorporated in and made a part of the order to which they are attached.

- 1. **Family members:** Includes a spouse, parent, child, step-child, any other person related by blood or present marriage, or a person who shares a common dwelling with the respondent.
- 2. **Firearms Restraining Order:** "FRO" means an order issued by the court, prohibiting and enjoining a named person from having in his or her custody or control any firearm, and purchasing, possessing, or receiving, any additional firearms.
- 3. **Intimate partner:** Includes a spouse, former spouse, a person with whom the respondent has or allegedly has a child in common, or a person with whom the respondent has or has had a dating or engagement relationship.
- 4. **Petitioner:** "Petitioner" means a family member or a law enforcement officer.
- 5. **Respondent:** "Respondent" means the person alleged in the petition to pose a danger of causing personal injury to himself, herself, or another by having in his or her custody or control any firearm, and purchasing, possessing, or receiving any additional firearms.
